## PHOTOGRAPHS:

Emailed photos are preferred. If you must mail a photo, it cannot be larger than 8" x 10". Photos should be sent at the same time as the registration form if at all possible. Please be sure to include \$7.50 if you want the photo returned to you, and the name and address for where it should be returned.
