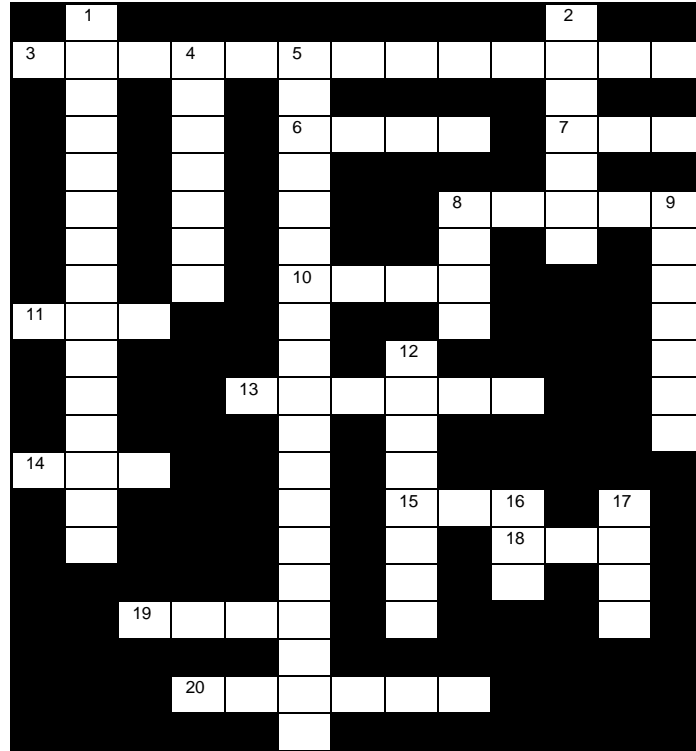


Airborne & Special Operations Museum OSS Crossword Puzzle



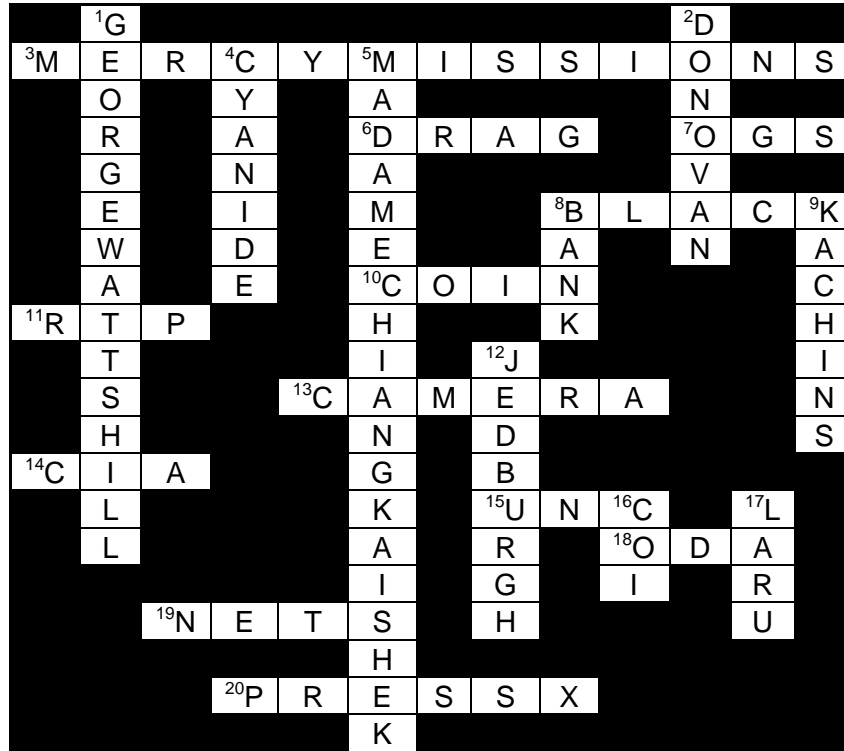
